Luke 10:2

Thoughts on the verse:

Is your heart breaking for the state that the world is in today? Is it so much sadness that it can be overwhelming at times? When we look through the lenses of our natural eyes, it can be all too easy to feel depressed and paralyzed at the vast darkness of it all. But doesn't the morning always come just after the darkest hour??? When we choose to look through the eyes of faith, we can see so much more clearly what God is doing in this hour. And what he said two thousand years ago is STILL for today: there are people out there that need a Savior. There are not enough of us out there harvesting to be able to bring them all in. So Jesus told us to PRAY and ask God to send out workers to the field. Notice He didn't just ask for workers, but He specifically said for workers to go into His harvest field. Prayer:

May You find us quick to obey Your Voice, and may it strengthen our bravery as we take ten seconds of courage to do each hard thing. We love You today Lord, and thank You for calling us to Your field, in Jesus' name.
